“Last year, there were about 35 children. For this year, we have 300 children,” Ms. Moses said.

These children are aged between 5 -12 years old and come from the settlements.

The gifts worth K2,000 were presented to the NCD Provincial Aids Committee Representative and the Provincial Care & Counseling Coordinator Rose Apini.

Mrs Apini said the 300 orphans gathered at the Honeybee, a little school along the Taurama Road was an ideal spot to have the function.

“These are children who are now orphans because their parents died of AIDS, or are living with parents who have AIDS,” Mrs. Apini said.
